## 1. General (Times 11, bold)

Contributed papers must be in English and should report previously unpublished work. The total length, including figures and references, is one A4 format page. The authors are responsible for the content and style of the contribution and no editing or retyping will be carried out by the Conference organizers. The accepted contributions will be reproduced without modification. Contributed papers which do not conform to the format described below may be rejected. Each abstract should be uploaded separately in electronic form on the conference website:

The abstract must be submitted in the Portable Document Format (.PDF).

All contributed papers will be refereed by the International Scientific Committee (ISC). Based on their scientific quality, the abstracts will be accepted or rejected. The ISC will also select a limited number of the accepted contributions for an oral presentation. A book of proceedings containing abstracts of the invited talks as well as all one page accepted abstracts will be distributed to the participants upon their arrival to the conference site.

**Deadline for receipt of abstracts is March 6, 2015.**

## 2. Recommendations for the text

### 2.1. Format

The abstract should be typewritten in **A4** format, using two columns and Times New Roman font (exactly according to the present template).

#### Margins:

Page – Top, Bottom: 2 cm

Title, author list and affiliations: 2.5 cm left and right.

Main text: 2 cm left and right.

Distance between columns: 0.5 cm.

#### Fonts:

Title: Times 14, Bold, centered

Authors' names: Times 12, normal, centered

Affiliations: Times 10, Italic, centered

Main text: Times 11, justified in left and right

Figure and table captions: Times 10, italic (except Fig. and Tab. and the corresponding number), centered.

Headings (Times 11, bold) are placed flush on the left-hand margin on a separate line.

### 2.3. Figures, tables and equations

Abstracts may include figures and tables. A caption should be below each figure and above each table. The captions are shown here:

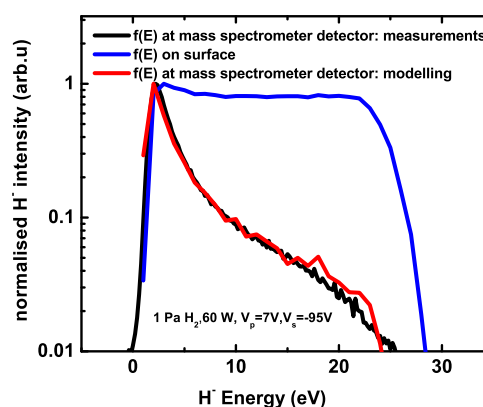


Fig. 1: A caption to a figure.

Please ensure good readability of text in figures. Equation numbers must be in parentheses and placed flush with right-hand margin of the column.
